POOL AND BEACH REMINDER

GUESTS

Members are responsible for their guests. Each member in good standing receives 20 complimentary, digital guest passes. Additional passes are \$5 per person/day. If you accompany your guests, simply check in with the pool monitor. If your guests will be unaccompanied, please find the Guest Authorization Form on the app or website and return it to pool@santarosaclub.com.

CHILDREN

Children under the age of three and those not fully potty trained must wear a snug fitting swim diaper when in the pool. Should the pool require closing due to a toileting accident, the responsible member will be charged a minimum of \$500 to recoup cleaning and loss of revenue cost.

DRESS CODE

As outlined in the COPs, appropriate swimwear suitable for a family atmosphere is permitted at the pool and beach area; however, a cover-up is required when on the Terrace. As a reminder, no swimwear is permitted inside Vue on 30a. No hats are to be worn by male patrons inside Vue on 30a's main dining area but are permitted in the lounge and bar areas.

Appropriate Attire Includes

For men

- Golf Slacks
- Standard length golf shorts
- Collared or mock neck golf shirts
- Clothing approved by the PGA Tour

For ladies

- Standard golf shirts, with or without collars, sleeve or sleeveless
- Standard golf shorts, skorts or skirts
- Clothing approved by the LPGA Tour

Inappropriate Attire Includes

- Jeans
- Defined as: men's, ladies or children's pants made of denim of any color
- Cut-offs (un-hemmed shorts)
- Gym shorts, short shorts, jogging shorts
- Tee shirts or jerseys
- Bathing suits
- Tops designed to be worn as undergarments
- Tank tops for men

We are a spikeless golf shoe facility. Golfers may wear either soft spiked golf shoes, flat soled sneakers/tennis shoes or any approved golf shoe wear supported by the major shoe companies.

IMPROVE YOUR CHIPPING LOWER YOUR SCORE

We all know the importance of a good short game and the number of shots that can be saved during a round of golf. However, many players do not understand the basic fundamentals of chipping; therefore, do not spend adequate time practicing correctly.

Practice the following basic fundamentals with all clubs for chipping:

SET-UP:

- Choke down on the grip – half way down on the grip is a good starting point.
- Position the ball in the center of your stance or slightly back of center.
- Narrow your stance, align your feet to the left of the target and create a nice flex in the knees. This helps to keep the lower body stable and quiet during the swing motion.
- Place 60% of your weight on the left leg. The combination of the ball position and your weight position will put your hands ahead of the clubhead and golf ball at address.

SWING MOTION:

- During the backswing, maintain 60% of your weight on the left leg. As the length of the backswing increases, allow the hips to rotate, but the weight should always stay left.
- On the forward swing, keep the hands and grip leading the clubface as you swing through the impact area...basically maintaining the same relationship that you had at the address position between the hands/grip and clubhead.
- As you swing through the impact area, allow the weight to increase on the left leg.

While there are modifications that can be made, depending on the shot you are playing, these basics will establish a foundation that will improve your chipping and prepare you for some additional shot creativity as you continue to improve in your chipping game.



GOLF COMMITTEE UPDATE

The newly formed 2019 golf committee held it's first meeting in May, followed by the June meeting. Your new committee: Mike Baggett-Chair, Cheryl Hoffman-LGA President, Ken Colbert, Kathy Shepherd, David Swart & Dianna Owings-LGA Vice President (attending meetings in Mrs. Hoffman's absence).

The committee focuses on all aspects of the golf operations with primary focus on:

- Tournament operations & scheduling
- Monitoring and regulating members' handicaps to ensure a fair and equitable playing field for all players and tournaments.
- Continuing to improve the overall golf experience for members and guests

Coming this fall: Adding to the 2019 tournament schedule will be a newly formed intraclub Ryder Cup event. Twenty-four members will participate with 12 players on each team. Non-playing captains will be selected for each of the teams. The committee will finalize the event plans, formats, etc. and will communicate to all golfing members.

The committee is currently working to determine the set up and operational procedures for the short game area. We are excited to see this area open late this summer/early fall and will be communicating procedures out to members.

Included in the plans, but not limited to, will be a list of golf courses in our area offering reduced rates, fun competitions that will be held on the practice range and short game area as well as scheduled member golf outings that will be arranged by Carter and staff. All information will be communicated to the membership well in advance of the scheduled course closing dates.

CHEF GIO's SHRIMP GORGONZOLA

½ oz olive oil
 3 U-12 shrimp
 1 oz diced Roma tomatoes
 4 oz white wine
 2 oz gorgonzola cheese
 1 clove garlic
 Salt and pepper to taste
 Chopped parsley
 2 slices of crostini made from baguette bread

Add oil to a hot sauté pan. When oil is up to temperature, add the shrimp and tomatoes and sauté for one minute. Next, add the garlic and wine and bring to a boil. Add the gorgonzola cheese and keep on the heat until the cheese begins to melt. Season with salt and pepper to taste and serve over crostini. Finish with chopped parsley.

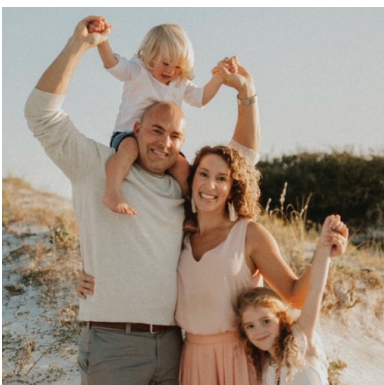

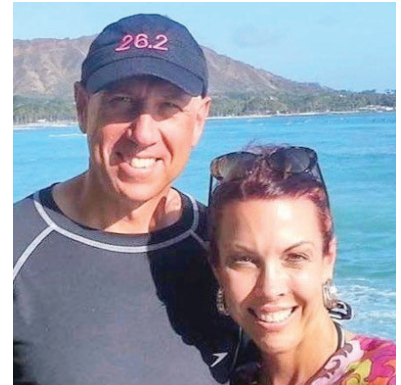

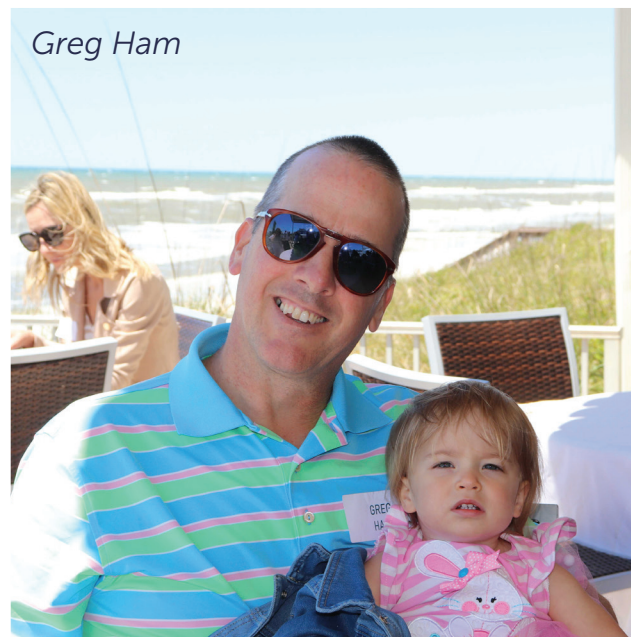
