GOLF COURSE MAINTENANCE UPDATE

he agronomy team is staying busy this winter! We continue to work on exposing more white sand in different areas of the course as time and resources allow. In addition, we have done bunker work on some of the problematic bunkers. The exposed bunker liner on the right greenside bunker on #4 was removed and we have reshaped that bunker face where it was becoming undermined. We did some minor reshaping to the left green-side on #6, the bunker on #15 and both bunkers on #16. The agronomy team has been busy trimming back Fakahatchee grass plant material and will continue to carry out these efforts on the Muhly grass plants as well. Additionally, we have removed dead trees and any other trees that have been marked for removal. This will continue moving forward as per the renovation plan. The team appreciates your continued support and we look forward to all that is to come in the months ahead.

THE PROBLEMS:

Inconsistent entry point into the sand, depth into the sand and length of the swing. All result in inconsistent contact and poor distance control.

THE SOLUTION:

Allow the body to rotate back and through based on the length of the shot/swing.



KEY 1

The first key is to have the proper set up at address. Play the ball forward in your stance towards your front foot with the club face slightly open. Keep your hands directly over the ball to utilize the bounce of the club. Placing the hands too far forward causes the club to dig and take too much sand.





KEY 2

After we allow our body to turn in our backswing, the second key is maintaining full arm extension into and through impact. This is achievable if the body rotates back and through while the arms stay passive. When we just swing our arms without turning our body, it becomes difficult to maintain proper arm extension.

KEY 3

One sure way to know if we turned our body properly is to hold our finish position and observe. Your weight should be 90% on your forward leg with your belt buckle and chest facing the target and your arms should be at full extension.

GOLF COMMITTEE UPDATE

With the wonderful increase in membership levels, the club's tournaments are filling up very quickly and many have waiting lists. It is recommended that all members pay close attention to the marketing and communications of all upcoming golf events. Please be aware that each tournament has a capacity and there is always a limit to the number of players that can participate. To avoid a waiting list, please register as soon as the sign up book becomes available in the golf shop. You must sign the event book to be eligible for the event. If you sign up for an event and decide not to play, please let the golf staff know as soon as possible so that alternates can be notified and have the opportunity to participate.

Invitations for the 2020 Men's Member-Guest will be sent out to eligible members in January. As this is always one of the most popular events at the club, please return the entry form information as soon as possible. The committee continues to discuss and monitor speed of play issues. Please be reminded that it is incumbent upon all players and groups to abide by the club's "4 hour" policy with no exceptions for fivesomes. If a speed of play issue arises, a golf staff member may request that your group either pick up the pace of play or skip the appropriate number of holes to catch back up to the 4 hour pace or group in front of your group. Everyone's cooperation is needed so that all golfers may enjoy their round of golf.

The Golf Committee is chaired by Mike Baggett. Committee members include Cheryl Hoffman, Dianna Owings, Ken Colbert, Kathy Shepherd and David Swart.

Pour in white wine. Add butter, garlic and lemon juice to create sauce. Toss to coat. Add salt and pepper to taste. Garnish with parsley and serve over puff pastry or bread.
